MINUTES

1. Pre-Meeting Social Gathering
2. Meeting called to order by Glenda Frost at 5:04PM.
3. Introductions and Ice Breaker facilitated by Frost.
4. Commission Agreements reviewed by Frost.
5. Meeting minutes approved.
6. Report Back
 - A. Youth Leadership Retreat: Nguyen did a detailed day-by-day account of the Youth Leadership retreat. He identified the two major goals of the youth commission for the next few months will be to get appointed and to have some kind of “function” to publicize the Youth Commission. Stromas added that UC Davis students also spoke with youth about college.
 - B. Youth Commission Intern Hiring: Baraona updated youth about Aida Mariam, a UC Berkeley student with experience from Congresswoman Barbara Lee’s office that will be hired as the Youth Advisory Commission intern. Tacdol also mentioned that Helen Wu, a Mills College student with experience in city commissions, will also be hired to do research on/for the Youth Advisory Commission.
8. Old/New Business
 - A. Committee Breakout

Public Service Announcement: Subcommittee Meeting will be on February 15, 2006 at 5:45PM. Baraona and Robinson suggested an idea to have youth in suits to “save-the-day” when there are problems in the community. The PSA committee must finish a storyboard by February 27, 2006.

Appointment Process: Subcommittee Meeting will be on February 15, 2006 at 4:15PM. Nguyen said that they need to arrange a meeting with the mayor, get in

contact with City Council members, figure out reasons to convince mayor to appoint the youth and to meet with all youth commissioners and advocates. Nguyen also confirmed with at least 4 youth commissioners to contact their Council people by the next meeting.

Youth Commission "Function": Subcommittee Meeting will be on March 6, 2006 at 4:30PM. Stromas, M. Gaines and A. Gaines want to have a dance/fundraiser. M. Gaines and A. Gaines will talk to step-dad about renting the Rotunda building. M. Gaines and Stromas will look into fliers. Stromas will also look into local rappers to perform. The suggested admission price will be \$3.00.

Mayoral Elections: Subcommittee Meeting will be February 15, 2006 at 5:00PM. Frost said that YAC needs to get the contact information for the candidates, interview candidates, create questions with the YAC, set up appointment and mention youth issues. Frost says that they should also do an exit interview with Mayor Brown.

 - ★ Andrea said that there was a news report on an increase in crime in the City Center area. She told youth commissioners to be careful and to try to have parents pick them up right outside of City Hall on 14th Street, where security guards and herself can keep an eye on you.
 - ★ Andrea reminded students of an upcoming meeting with Youth Media Council that they mentioned at the educational they did at a meeting. It will be on February 23 at La Pena Cultural Center from 4-7PM.
