CORE II - Neighborhood Preparedness/Response

- Utilize basic community organizing principles to involve neighbors

- Set up an Neighborhood Command Center (neighborhood emergency operations center)
- Create emergency response teams for communications, damage assessment, hazards reduction, light search and rescue, disaster first aid, shelter and special needs
